Camden Starting Primary School in Camden

Camden has some of the best primary schools in the country. All our primary schools are currently rated either 'good' or 'outstanding' by Ofsted. Your child will be due to start primary school in September 2025 if they were born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021. The next round of applications begins from 1 September 2024. You need to apply by 15 January 2025.
